Introduction and Objectives:

Shikshan Prasarak Sanstha's, **P. V. P. Mahavidyalaya, Kavathe Mahankal** was established in the year 1978. The college aims at the overall development of the students to become entrepreneurs and professionals in the respective disciplines. IQAC of the college conducted a Student Satisfaction Survey regarding Teaching – Learning and Evaluation for the academic year 2021-22. It will help to upgrade the quality in higher education. Receiving positive or negative feedback from these students is important as both are crucial in helping monitor and evaluate the provision. Listening to what student say is a contributing factor to running a successful college or institution. This survey was developed to capture students' evaluation about teacher, facilities and curriculum related issues.

Methodology

In every academic year, we ask our students to fill a Students Satisfaction Survey form (SSS) which is made available on college website. Filling of SSS is voluntary/ optional. For the academic year 2021-22, there were 1820 registered students at the college. The data was collected during the period 1st January 2022 to 31st May 2020. The link of SSS form was also made available to students on their email address. One thousand and twenty seven (1027) students responded to the survey, providing a response rate of 57%. The analysis presented in this report is based on the responses of the 1027 respondents to the survey.


Respondent Profile


The respondent sample is broadly representative of the student population with respect to gender, programme level and course. Most respondents are pursuing programmes at the bachelor's degree level.

Overall Evaluation


Feedback was collected and analyzed by Feedback Analysis Committee of the college. Opinion of the students is obtained about each parameter in terms of percentage.


About 98% students said that syllabus covered in the class is more than 90%. About 94% of all students reported that they are being satisfied about the teacher's preparation for the class.







About 97% of the students indicated that all teachers' communication is always effective while about 99.50% of students described teachers approach about teaching is satisfactory.







About 95% of the students agree that there is fairness in the internal evaluation processed by teachers while about 93% of the students agree that their performance in assignments discussed with them.







